STUDENT TRAVEL SUPPORT TO THE 36TH INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON COMBUSTION

**July 31-August 5, 2016
Seoul, South Korea**

The Eastern States Section of the Combustion Institute (ESSCI) is pleased to provide financial travel support to students from ESSCI institutions who will be delivering oral presentations at the 36th International Symposium on Combustion to be held in Seoul, South Korea beginning July 31, 2016 and concluding August 5, 2016. The anticipated level of support is up to \$800 per award, but this could be changed depending on the number of applicants.

Qualified students must be a current degree candidate at a university from the ESSCI at the time of the conference and must be accompanied by a senior co-worker or advisor, who is a co-author on the presentation, at the meeting. Note that students must be delivering an oral presentation: students who are only co-authors on an oral presentation or delivering a poster presentation are **not** eligible for support.

To apply for ESSCI student travel support, please send the following information to Prof. Michael E. Mueller, Treasurer of the Eastern States Section of the Combustion Institute, via email (muellerm@princeton.edu) as soon as possible but no later than July 1, 2016 in order to determine the final budget:

The checks will be sent out immediately after the Symposium, and all awardees will be promptly notified when the checks are mailed.
